**AUTHORISATION TO USE PAINTS CONTAINING
LEAD CARBONS OR LEAD SULPHATES IN IRELAND**

Regulation (EC) No. 552/2009 of 22 June 2009 amending Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) as regards Annex XVII

Notes:

1. In accordance with entries 16 and 17 of Annex XVII to the REACH Regulation, Lead Carbons and Lead Sulphates may not be used as substances and constituents of preparations intended for use as paints, except for the restoration and maintenance of works of art and historic buildings.
2. Historic buildings are those structures included in or those proposed to be included in the Record of Protected Structures (RPS) as maintained by the relevant Planning Authority in the area where the historic structure is located and those structures included in the 'Record of Monuments and Places' as maintained by the Department of the Environment, Heritage and Local Government.
3. Work using lead paints must be carried out in accordance with the requirements of the Safety, Health and Work (Chemical Agents) Regulations, S.I. 619 of 2001.
4. A copy of the Safety Data Sheet for the paint should be attached with this application.
