European Communities (Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road and Use of Transportable Pressure Equipment) Regulations 2011 to 2023

Competent Authority Approval for the transport by road of **UN 3380 2,4-dinitrophenylhydrazine (wetted with not less than 33% water)**.

In accordance with the provisions of ADR, special provision 311 and packing instruction P099, the Health and Safety Authority, as competent authority appointed under Regulation 10 of the European Communities (Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road and Use of Transportable Pressure Equipment) Regulations 2011 to 2023, and in accordance with Regulation 5(4)(a), hereby approves the transport by road of UN 3380 WASTE DESENSITIZED EXPLOSIVE, SOLID, N.O.S. (2,4-Dinitrophenylhydrazine), 4.1, PG I, (B) wetted with not less than 33% water.

The transport operations shall comply with the provisions contained in this document.

1. Carriage shall be in accordance with ADR special provision 311 and packing instruction P099.
2. The substance shall be contained in the original inner packaging or in screw cap glass containers. Inner packaging(s) shall be sealed to prevent the loss of water during transport and screw cap closures taped.
3. The substance shall be wetted to at least 33% water content prior to shipping.
4. The substance must be packaged in an outer packaging conforming to ADR 6.1.5.1.7 and accordingly marked with the letter "V", indicating the outer packaging is suitable for any article or inner packaging, for solids or liquids and having been tested to packing group I. The outer package shall be limited to half the marked gross mass.
5. Outer packaging shall otherwise be used in accordance with the instruction of use provided by the packaging manufacturer.
6. Mixed packing with any other articles or substances is not permitted.
7. Classification and packing may only be carried out by or under the supervision of a dangerous goods safety adviser.
8. In all other respects, the transport operations performed in accordance with this approval will comply with the relevant requirements of ADR.
9. A copy of this approval or an indication in the transport document that the packaging has been approved by the competent authority must accompany each shipment.

10. Any incident resulting in loss of containment of a substance during the transport journey shall be reported immediately by the participant in control of the transport operation to the:

11. The Authority may withdraw this approval for failure to observe any of these conditions or for any other reason, which the Authority deems sufficient.

12. This approval shall not be used as documentary proof of correct classification. Classification remains the responsibility of the consignor.

This approval is effective immediately and expires on 31 January 2026.
