



The European Communities (Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road and Use of Transportable Pressure Equipment) Regulations 2011 and 2013

Competent Authority Exemption 04 / 2013

Applicable To National Road Transport Only

Use of Road Tank vehicles with fixed tanks manufactured by GRW Engineering (Pty) Ltd

In accordance with the provisions of ADR, the Health and Safety Authority, as competent authority appointed under Regulation 10 of the European Communities (Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road and Use of Transportable Pressure Equipment) Regulations 2011 and 2013, and in accordance with Regulation 5 (4) (a) of the said regulations, hereby exempts tanks manufactured by GRW Engineering (Pty) Ltd (GRW) fitted to road tank vehicles from certain provisions of the European Agreement Concerning the International Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road (ADR), namely type approval and initial certification.

Purpose

Road tank vehicles, fitted with tanks manufactured by GRW have been incorrectly issued with type approval and initial inspection certification by Bureau Veritas South Africa and Bureau Veritas UK.


This exemption permits the continued use of these road tankers subject to the alternative carriage provisions detailed below.

The following supplementary provisions shall be complied with:

1. This exemption is limited to road tank vehicles with tanks manufactured by GRW registered in Ireland.
2. This exemption shall have effect for those road tank vehicles affected until the time of the next periodic or intermediate (thorough or leakproofness) inspection, whichever is due first, when the tank shall be inspected, repaired or modified as may be necessary and recertified by an appropriate inspection body.
3. Road tank vehicles shall be subject to exceptional checks, inspection and testing as may be specified by this Authority.
4. The tank vehicles affected shall continue to be subject to annual vehicle approval certification, but shall be limited to national use only.

5. Road tank vehicles fitted with tanks manufactured by GRW and authorised for continued use by the appropriate authorities in Northern Ireland and in Great Britain in their territory may also be used in Ireland.
6. A copy of this exemption must accompany the transport documentation and shall be made available to anyone having a legitimate interest in the shipment.
7. Any incident resulting in loss of containment of a substance during the transport journey shall be reported immediately in writing to this Authority.
8. The Authority may withdraw this exemption for failure to observe any of these conditions, or for any other reason which the Authority deems sufficient.
9. In all other respects the relevant requirements of ADR shall be complied with.

This exemption is effective immediately and expires on **30th June 2016**.
