The Health and Safety Authority (HSA) has developed a free online course called 'Chemical Safety in the Workplace – Level 2'. This 30-minute interactive course follows on from the Chemical Safety in the Workplace introductory course. Hazardous chemicals can be found in nearly all workplaces and their safe use is essential for health and well-being. Health effects can range from irritation of the skin or eyes to cancers and effects on the unborn child. Take this short course to learn about chemical hazards, labels and Safety Data Sheets (SDSs) and managing chemical safety. The content is suitable for employers and employees, including supervisors and health and safety representatives, in any sector where chemicals are used.
