

HAZARDOUS CHEMICALS

Are you at Risk?

Workers in the Motor Vehicle Repair industry may be exposed to different hazards, including hazardous chemicals.







- Be aware that hazardous substances, such as exhaust gases and fine dusts, can also begenerated during MVR work
- Be informed read <u>hazard</u> labels and safety data sheets
- Use correct work clothing to protect skin and eyes
- When applying isocyanate-based products, always wear appropriate air-fed breathing apparatus inside spray-booths/spray-rooms and follow clearance times
- Regularly check hands for dryness and soreness and use skin creams as instructed

- Store chemicals safely and securely
- Keep the work area clean and clear up spills
- Follow emergency procedures and participate in health surveillance programmes
- Never clean hands with concentrated cleaning products or solvents
- Never decant concentrated chemicals into an unlabelled container
