If something doesn't seem safe it probably isn't



- 1 A safety representative is elected by workers to represent them.
- 2 They can inspect the workplace if the employer agrees.
- 3 They can investigate incidents.
- 4 Safety representatives get information from the Health and Safety Authority inspector.
- 5 They may accompany the Health and Safety Authority inspector if the inspector agrees.
- 6 They bring any concerns to their employer or the Health and Safety Authority.
- 7 They may consult other safety representatives from the same employer.
- 8 It is against the law to ignore or discriminate against safety representatives.
