



10 Top Tips for SIEF Participants

- 1. If you are a pre-registrant, then you must participate in a SIEF unless you do not intend to register
- 2. You are not obliged to exchange money to become a member of a SIEF
- 3. Get involved, communicate within your SIEF, especially if you intend to register in 2010
- 4. Ensure that a Lead Registrant (LR) is selected and agreed upon within your SIEF, for the purposes of Joint Submission
- 5. Contact your LR to inform him that you are an active SIEF member
- 6. Keep up to date with all communications and react to any requests from your LR within the set timelines. Your silence may lead to a misinterpretation that you do not wish to be an active participant and you may miss the joint submission
- 7. Remember, you are obliged to share data for the purposes of Registration
- 8. You must be part of the Joint Registration Submission unless you have valid reasons to 'opt out'
- 9. Note that ECHA will not participate in discussions between potential registrants and will not confirm or disallow the creation of a particular SIEF
- 10. Also, note that Consortia Members within a SIEF cannot proceed with a Joint Submission without the agreement of other SIEF participants
