# Farm Safely with Slurry



This short online course from the Health and Safety Authority will help farmers to plan and prepare for slurry spreading. The course will address the best times and conditions for spreading slurry, and the importance of planning ahead.

The 30-minute interactive course will help raise awareness of the dangers associated with slurry, in particular slurry gas. The safety measures required to be in place and the prevention of accidents will also be addressed on this course.
