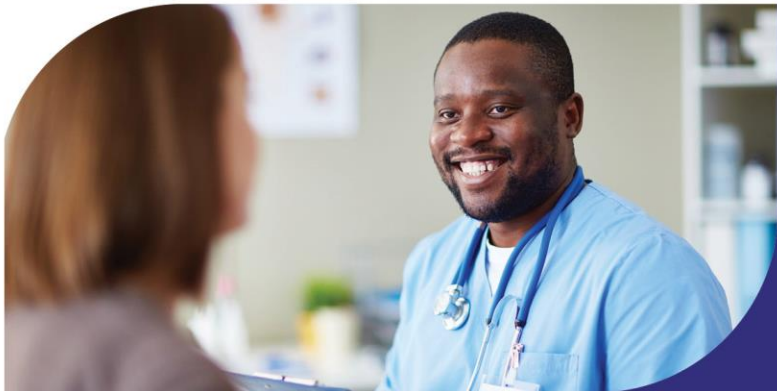

Safety Culture

*"The product of **individual and group values, attitudes, perceptions, competencies and patterns of behaviour** that can determine the commitment to, and the style and proficiency of an organisation's health and safety management system".*

*Health and Safety Commission Advisory Committee on the safety of nuclear installations
(1993)*

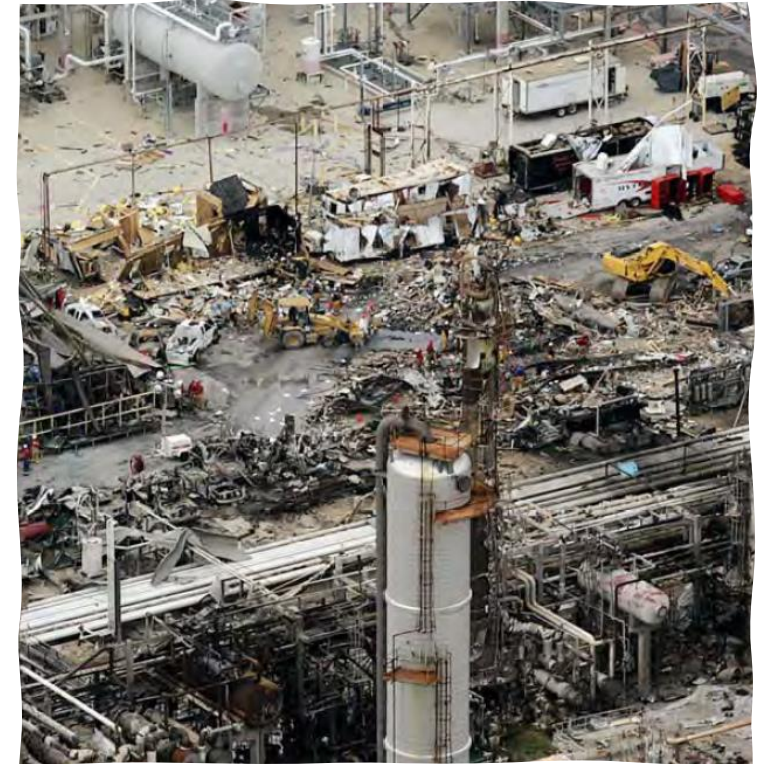

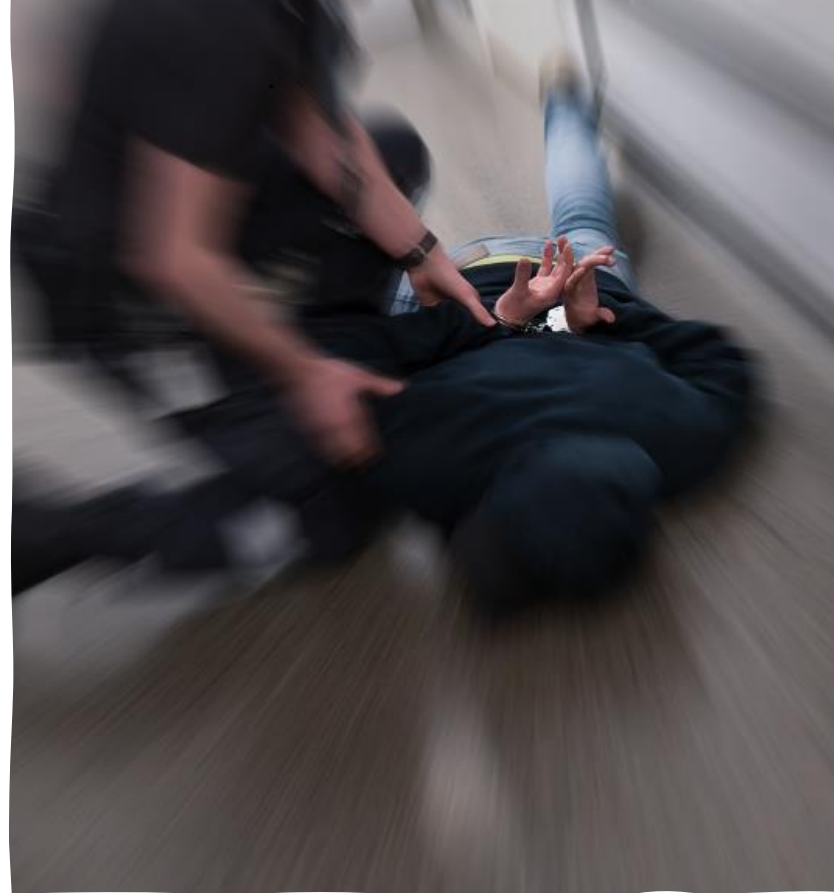

- ✓ Response
- ✓ Balance of health and safety and organisational goals
- ✓ Resources and support



Safety Critical Communication

Quality Clarity Timing

Organisational Learning

- ✓ Analysis of incidents
- ✓ Focus on underlying causes
- ✓ Looking beyond human error - systems approach
- ✓ Timely feedback and action

Influencing Safety Culture

- Manage expectations
- Engage at all levels
- Communicate as you go
- Capture what people feel and do, what the organisation has
- Focus on one topic

Key Messages

- Safety culture > what people feel, do, what the organization has
- Management commitment, communication, organisational learning
- Intervention > Ensure engagement at all levels, ongoing communication; focus on one topic

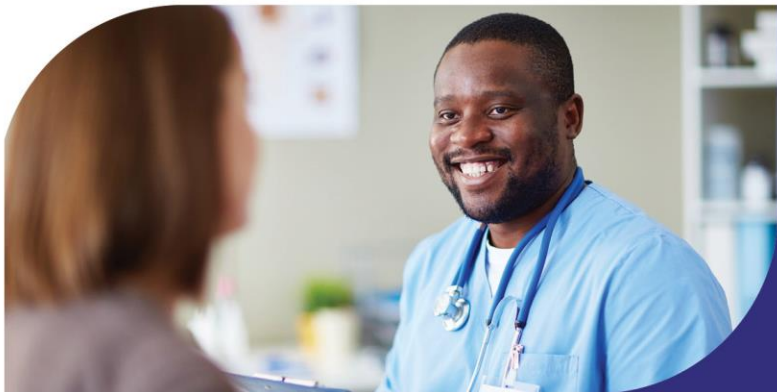
