



European Communities (Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road and Use of Transportable Pressure Equipment) Regulations 2011 to 2019

Competent Authority Approval 05/2020

Applicable to National Road Transport Only

ADR 2.2.41.1.13 provides that classification of self-reactive substances not listed in ADR 2.2.41.4, 4.1.4.2, packing instruction IBC520, or 4.2.5.2 portable tank instruction T23, and assignment to a collective entry, shall be made by the Competent Authority of the country of origin based on a test report. The statement of the approval shall contain the classification and the relevant conditions of carriage.

In accordance with ADR 2.2.41.1.13, the Health and Safety Authority, as Competent Authority appointed under Regulation 10 of the European Communities (Carriage of Dangerous Goods and Use of Transportable Pressure Equipment) Regulations 2011 to 2019, hereby grants competent authority approval to **Indaver Ireland Limited** for the carriage by road of UN 3227, SELF-REACTIVE LIQUID, TYPE E (4-chloro-5-fluoro-6-vinylpyrimidine), Class 4.1 (self-accelerating decomposition temperature (SADT) 60°C for a 50kg package) as a WASTE.

This approval relates only to the carriage by road of WASTE UN 3227, SELF-REACTIVE LIQUID, TYPE E (4-chloro-5-fluoro-6-vinylpyrimidine), Class 4.1, by Indaver Ireland Limited

- from two active pharmaceutical plants, Pfizer Ireland Pharmaceuticals, Ringaskiddy, Cork and Little Island, Cork (Upjohn Manufacturing), to the Indaver Ireland Limited Transfer Station, North Dock, Dublin Port, and
- from Indaver Ireland Limited Transfer Station, North Dock, Dublin Port to the shipping terminal at Dublin Port.

Conditions for carriage:

1. The WASTE substance shall be carried in accordance with ADR packing instruction P520, packing method OP8 as specified in ADR special provision 4.1.7.1.
2. The maximum quantity to be carried per packaging/package shall be 50kg.
3. Packages shall be securely fastened to and contained within the transport unit to prevent lateral or longitudinal movement.
4. In all other respects, the relevant requirements of ADR shall be complied with.



5. This document shall not be used as documentary proof of correct classification. Classification remains the responsibility of the consignor. Indaver Ireland Limited is the consignor of the WASTE UN 3227, SELF-REACTIVE LIQUID, TYPE E (4-chloro-5-fluoro-6-vinylpyrimidine), Class 4.1, by means of a contract for carriage in accordance with the European Communities (Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road and use of Transportable Pressure Equipment) Regulations 2011 to 2019.
6. A copy of this approval must accompany the transport documentation and shall be made available to anyone having a legitimate interest in the carriage of this substance.
7. Any incident resulting in loss of containment of a substance during the transport journey shall be reported by the operator to:
