European Communities (Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road and Use of Transportable Pressure Equipment) Regulations 2011 to 2023

Competent Authority Approval for the transport by road of UN 2014, HYDROGEN PEROXIDE AQUEOUS SOLUTION in tank portable tanks after the due date of inspection in accordance with ADR 6.7.2.19.2

In accordance with ADR 6.7.2.19.6.1, the Health and Safety Authority, as competent authority appointed under Regulation 10 of the European Communities (Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road and Use of Transportable Pressure Equipment) Regulations 2011 to 2023, and in accordance with Regulation 5(4)(a), hereby approves the carriage of dangerous goods in 11 portable tanks, filled prior to the due date of periodic inspection and test in accordance with 6.7.2.19.2, for a period of more than three months after the due date of inspection.

Until the date of expiry of this approval, 11 portable tanks of serial numbers listed below are approved to carry UN 2014, HYDROGEN PEROXIDE AQUEOUS SOLUTION, 5.1 (8), II, from **Chemco Ireland Limited**, Damastown Rise, Damastown, Dublin 15 to **ENVA Ireland Limited**, Greenogue Business Park, Rathcoole, Dublin 24.

The transport operations shall comply with the provisions contained in this document.

1. A copy of this approval shall be carried in the vehicle.

2. For each transport operation, the transport document shall make reference to this approval and to 6.7.2.19.6.1.
3. The carrier shall carry out a prestart visual inspection of the portable tanks before and after loading onto the trailers.
4. For every transport operation from Chemco Ireland Limited to Enva Ireland Limited under the provisions of this approval, there shall be an emergency vehicle available at the premises of Chemco Ireland Limited, Damastown Rise, Damastown, Dublin 15; such vehicle shall have on board additional spill containment equipment, extra seals and gaskets.
5. In all other respects, the transport operations performed in accordance with this approval will comply with the relevant requirements of ADR.
6. Any incident resulting in loss of containment of a substance during the transport journey shall be reported immediately by the participant in control of the transport operation to the:

8. This approval shall not be used as documentary proof of correct classification. Classification remains the responsibility of the consignor.
