



European Communities (Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road and Use of Transportable Pressure Equipment) Regulations 2011 to 2015

**Competent Authority Approval 02/2016**

Applicable to National Road Transport Only

Extension of the interval for the periodic inspection of refillable welded steel cylinders in accordance with ADR 4.1.4.1, P200, special packing provision v(2) of paragraph 10.

In accordance with ADR transitional provision 1.6.2.9, the provisions of ADR subsection 4.1.4.1, packing instruction P200, paragraph 10, special packing provision 'v', applicable until 31<sup>st</sup> December 2010, provide that for cylinders constructed before 1 January 2015, the interval between inspections for steel cylinders may be extended to 15 years

- (a) With the agreement of the competent authority (authorities) of the country (countries) where the periodic inspection and the carriage take place; and
- (b) In accordance with the requirements of a technical code or a standard recognised by the competent authority, or standard EN 1440:1996 "Transportable refillable welded cylinders for liquefied petroleum gas (LPG) – periodic requalification".

The Health and Safety Authority, as Competent Authority appointed under Regulation 10 of the European Communities (Carriage of Dangerous Goods and Use of Transportable Pressure Equipment) Regulations 2011 to 2015, hereby approves the carriage by road of refillable welded steel cylinders of gas capacities 5Kg, 11Kg, 11.34Kg, 19Kg, 34Kg and 47Kg constructed before 1 January 2015 for which the interval between inspections has been extended to 15 years by **Calor Teoranta**, in accordance with the requirements of standard EN 1440:1996 "Transportable refillable welded cylinders for liquefied petroleum gas (LPG) – periodic requalification", as referenced and amended in ADR 6.2.4.2.

This approval is effective immediately.
