

European Communities (Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road and Use of Transportable Pressure Equipment) Regulations 2011

Competent Authority Approval 04/ 2011

Applicable To National Road Transport Only

Transport by road of UN 3380 2,4-dinitrophenylhydrazine, (wetted with not less than 30% water).

In accordance with the provisions of ADR, special provision 311 and packing instructions P099, the Health & Safety Authority, as competent authority appointed under Regulation 10 of the European Communities (Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road and Use of Transportable Pressure Equipment) Regulations 2011, hereby approves the transport by road of 2,4 dinitrophenylhydrazine, wetted with not less than 30% water (Classification: UN 3380, Desensitized Explosive, Solid, N.O.S., Class 4.1, PG I, (B)) under the conditions stated in this document.

Conditions of carriage:

The substance must be packaged in an outer packaging of type UN Fibreboard box 4G/X../..; containing one inner packaging, namely, a glass bottle fitted with a plastic screw cap, containing a maximum of 500g of wetted (with not less than 30% water) 2,4-dinitrophenylhydrazine. The free space between the inner packaging and the outer packaging shall be filled with inert, non-combustible cushioning material. Packaging shall be designed, constructed and used to prevent the loss of water or contents.

The following supplementary provisions shall be complied with:

1. In all other respects the relevant requirements of ADR shall be complied with.

2. This approval is only valid from point of consignment to the consignee's premises; it is not valid for any subsequent journeys.

3. Any incident resulting in loss of containment of the substance during the transport journey shall be reported immediately in writing to this Authority.

4. This document shall not be used as documentary proof of correct classification. Classification remains the responsibility of the consignor.

5. A copy of this approval must accompany the transport documentation and shall be made available to anyone having a legitimate interest in the carriage of this substance.

6. The Authority may amend or withdraw this approval for failure to observe any of the above conditions, or for any other reason which the Authority deems sufficient.

This approval is effective from 1 Dec 2011
