



European Communities (Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road and Use of Transportable Pressure Equipment) Regulations 2011 to 2019

Competent Authority Exemption CA (E) 01/2020

Applicable To National Road Transport Only

The Health and Safety Authority as competent authority appointed under Regulation 10(1)(g) of the European Communities (Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road and Use of Transportable Pressure Equipment) Regulations 2011 to 2019, in accordance with Regulation 5(4)(a), hereby exempts

Tank 2531, Type Approval No. GB/FT/RSA/1112, tank vehicle Registration No. 07LS1749, operated by Emo Oil Limited, Clonminham Industrial Estate, Portlaoise, Co. Laois.

from the requirements of ADR 6.8.2.4.5.

This exemption is granted under the provisions of Competent Authority Exemption 02/2017, and is based on the results of an exceptional check in accordance with ADR 6.8.2.4.4, carried out by an accredited inspection body approved by the Competent Authority.

The tank may continue to operate for the purposes of national transport only and the transport operation shall comply with the conditions stated in this exemption.

The following supplementary provisions shall be complied with:

1. A copy of this exemption shall be carried in the vehicle.
2. ADR test, inspection and certification activities shall be performed by an accredited inspection body approved by the competent authority.
3. The tank shall be used for the carriage of Class 3 substances only. The tank shell and its equipment must undergo periodic inspection and intermediate inspection in accordance with ADR 6.8.2.4.2 and 6.8.2.4.3 respectively. The tank-vehicle operator shall adhere to the specified due date for inspection.

A copy of the certificate of periodic or intermediate inspection shall be forwarded without delay to:

4. Any incident resulting in loss of containment of a substance during the transport journey shall be reported by the operator to the Health and Safety Authority at the address above.
5. The Authority may withdraw this exemption for failure to observe any of these conditions or for any other reason which the Authority deems sufficient.
6. In all other respects the relevant requirements of ADR shall be complied with.
7. This exemption is valid until the date of expiry, provided no changes are made to the ADR which would affect this approval in the intervening period.

This exemption is effective immediately and expires on **30 January 2023**.
