

European Communities (Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road and Use of Transportable Pressure Equipment) Regulations 2011 to 2019

Competent Authority Exemption CA (E) 06/2020

Applicable To National Road Transport Only

The Health and Safety Authority as Competent Authority appointed under Regulation 10(1)(g) of the European Communities (Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road and Use of Transportable Pressure Equipment) Regulations 2011 to 2019, in accordance with Regulation 5(4)(a), hereby exempts

Tank-vehicle, Registration Number 07MN2689, vehicle identification number YV2VBM0A17B472597, operated by Bluebell Way Limited (trading as McCormacks Fuel), 22 Mailcoach Road, Sligo

from the requirements of ADR 6.8.2 with regard to the certificate of type approval and initial inspection and test.

This exemption is granted under the provisions of Competent Authority Exemption 02/2017, and is based on the results of an exceptional check in accordance with ADR 6.8.2.4.4, carried out by an accredited inspection body approved by the Competent Authority.

The tank may continue to operate for the purposes of national transport only and the transport operation shall comply with the conditions stated in this exemption.

The following supplementary provisions shall be complied with:

- 1. A copy of this exemption shall be carried in the vehicle.
- 2. The tank-vehicle will be permitted to carry the ADR Class 3 substances UN No. 1202 and UN No. 1223 only.
- 3. Any incident resulting in loss of containment of a substance during the transport journey shall be reported by the operator to the Health and Safety Authority at the following address.

- 4. The Authority may withdraw this exemption for failure to observe any of these conditions or for any other reason, which the Authority deems sufficient.
- 5. In all other respects, the relevant requirements of ADR shall be complied with.
- 6. This exemption is valid until the date of expiry, which is three years from the date of exceptional check/inspection. It will remain valid until that date provided no changes are made to the ADR which would affect this exemption in the intervening period.

This exemption is effective immediately and expires on 05 October 2023.
