1 CHOOSE SAFETY

SAFETY FOR YOUNG PEOPLE AT WORK



Is a classroom-based programme with 6 units aimed at students.

Topics include law, risk assessment, control measures and specific hazards e.g. fire. Materials are provided for free.



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Awareness raising courses such as “Get Safe – Work Safe: Health and Safety in the Workplace for Students Starting Work” and “Health and Safety in the Workplace for Apprentices”.

2 “Workplace Safety, Health and Welfare Induction”

Is a free elearning course with 8 units (1+2 compulsory) aimed at students on work experience. Units include manual handling, noise and machinery.
